

# TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP ON TRANSITION MANAGEMENT

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## TWG on Transition Management TERMS OF REFERENCE

Be responsible for the transition management plan from the current basic education cycle to the K to 12 basic education cycle. The transition management plan shall address the transition issues on:

Organization and administrative structures and arrangements

HR requirement and development


Private schools' concerns

Physical facilities

**In the transition to K to 12, we must partner with other education stakeholders in introducing senior high school**


*Possible arrangements with HEIs, Technical Vocational schools, and Private High Schools*

- 1** HEIs / Private High Schools /techvoc schools will fully implement/manage Grades 11-12
- 2** DepEd will lease HEIs/private high schools and techvoc schools' facilities
- 3** Combination of 1 and 2

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**Two Programs for Transition Management**

- 1 SHS System Readiness Assessment**  
To (1) determine **current absorptive capacity per region** of all educational institutions (i.e. 'supply'), (2) ascertain **current industry & employment demand** and anticipate future opportunities (i.e. 'demand'), (3) and **ensure the SHS system will be instrumental in adequately addressing both.**  
*>> match supply with demand >>*
- 2 K to 12 Modeling**  
To **develop K to 12 model schools** per region and specialization tracks **by introducing senior high school in select schools, ahead of the planned nationwide implementation** on SY 2016-2017.

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# Senior High School (SHS) System Readiness Assessment

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## SHS System Readiness Assessment **EXPECTED OUTPUTS/OUTCOMES:**

- List of schools ready to offer SHS on or before 2016-2017
- Mapping of local education absorptive capacity to current & future industry & employment opportunities
- Type of support/interventions to be provided to the schools needing additional resources
- Financial schemes and partnership arrangements with the different types of private schools and HEIs

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## SHS System Readiness Assessment will gather the following data:

- A. Level of Education Offered
- B. Student Data
- C. Physical Facilities Data
- D. Faculty and Personnel
- E. Support Services
- F. School Information
- G. Nearby Operating Industries
- H. Existing Memorandum of Agreements with Relevant Entities and its Terms of Agreement

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# K TO 12 MODELING

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## K to 12 Modeling

### EXPECTED OUTPUTS/OUTCOMES:

- Establish/strengthen partnership with major industries in providing opportunities for employment, on-the-job training, dual training system, etc.
- Ascertain best possible models replicable by schools implementing Senior High School
- Test different implementation schemes according to school's curricular offering/preference

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## K to 12 Modeling

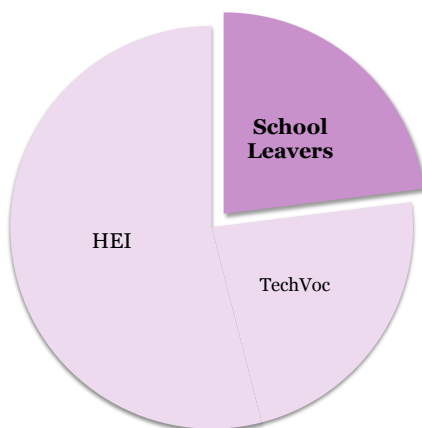
### EXPECTED OUTPUTS/OUTCOMES:

- Strengthen model schools through appropriate interventions (e.g. training for teachers, provision of instruction materials)
- Prepare and carry out the communication plan to generate support from media, civil society, academe, LGUs, private sectors, etc.

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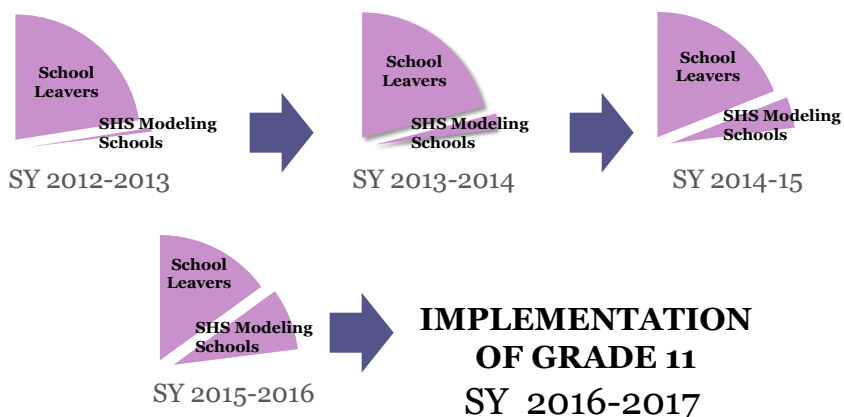
For every 100 high school graduates, 77 proceed to post-secondary education (54 to higher education institutions, 23 to technical-vocational schools), **23 are school leavers**



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We aim to reduce school leavers through K to 12 modeling, providing access to free post-secondary education (in public schools)



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## Progress of K to 12 Modeling

- Preliminary shortlist of 24 nominated schools
- Criteria for initial shortlisting of nominated schools:
  1. Public schools: existing post-secondary program or capability to offer post-secondary program
  2. Private schools: existing K to 12 like program or willingness and capability to model the program
  3. Current linkages with industries and LGUs or availability of industries/LGUs to provide support and work opportunities for students/graduates
- RDs / Regional TWGs can nominate more schools.

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## K to 12 Transition for Private Schools

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## Schools must adhere to the following

1. Age requirement – Grade 1 at age 6 after at least 1 year in Kinder/pre-school
2. Duration – minimum 1 year of Kinder/pre-school followed by 12 years of basic education
3. Curriculum – must follow (at the minimum) the K to 12 basic education curriculum

For private schools:

- Schools with 7 years of elementary conform to the prescribed K to 12 duration
- Schools with 6 years of elementary lack one grade level

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## Transition Examples for Schools with 7 Years Elementary

### Example 1

- Current Grade 7 students will go through 4 years of high school and proceed to college in 2016
- Current Grade 6 students will go through K to 12 Grade 7 (i.e. Junior High Year 1) in June, and 6-year HS program overall (**1 additional grade level**)

### Example 2

- Simultaneously and gradually upgrade curriculum in all year levels from 2012-2015
- In SY 2015-2016, all year levels are re-labeled to clearly show K to 12 progression
- **No additional grade level**

In both options, incoming 6 year olds go to Grade 1 and not Kinder 2 or Prep

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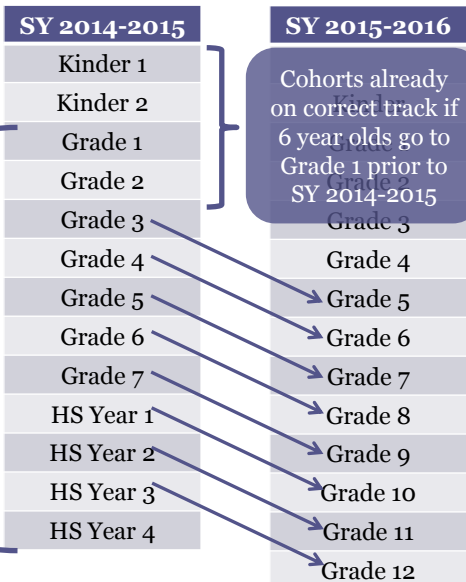
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## Example 2 for Private Schools with 7 Years Elementary

**Upgraded curriculum**

Implications:

1. No additional grade level
2. Students will be accelerated in form after SY 2014-2015



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## Transition Examples for Schools with 6 Years Elementary

### Example 1

- Current Grade 6 students will go through K to 12 Grade 7 (i.e. Junior High Year 1) in June, and 6-year HS program overall
- **2 additional grade levels**

### Example 2

- Simultaneously and gradually upgrade curriculum in all year levels from 2012-2015
- In SY 2015-2016, all year levels are re-labeled to clearly show K to 12 progression
- **1 additional grade level**

In both examples, incoming 6 year olds go to Grade 1 and not Kinder 2 or Prep
