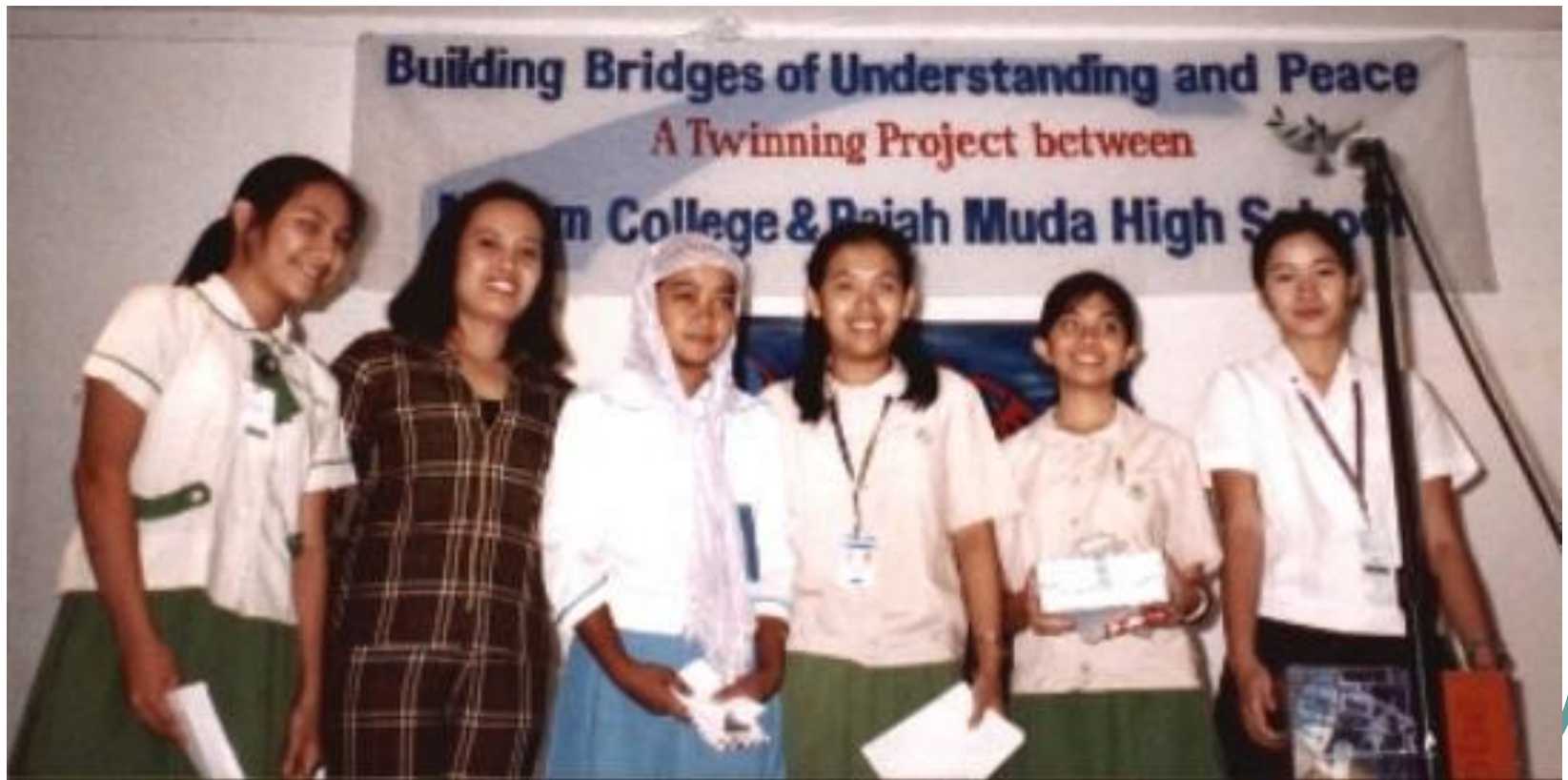
- Inclusion of **Interfaith Dialogue** as a topic in Theology
