This two-day seminar focuses on educational administrators, specifically deans, in all of their various emergent roles and functions, such as academic management, faculty development, program development and marketing of programs. The two-day seminar will feature veteran deans and former deans now in higher academic leadership positions. Topics will include how to handle day to day problems, effective supervision and evaluation of faculty, strategic planning and predicting future trends, internationalization and linkages. for Academic Affairs, Deans and other top and middle-level academic administrators will benefit from this seminar.

### Leadership Practices for Higher Education (LPHE)

November 17-18, 2011 (Thursday/Friday)

This two-day seminar brings together academic and institutional leaders whose practice and experience serve as lessons to the various dimensions and interpretation of leadership. Improving institutional effectiveness especially in higher education calls for leadership principles and inspiring stories that administrators can draw from to initiate and apply new leadership and governance practices. Leadership in higher education needs to take on more progressive and creative directions if universities and colleges are to forward quality and institutional effectiveness in their respective domains. Topics include: leading in a changing internal and external environment, managing conflict, innovating and alternative higher education systems, leading for quality and achieving a culture of quality enhancement in academe.
