NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE ENGAGEMENT OF ACADEME
IN VOLUNTEERING (NCEAV)

In commemoration of the *National Volunteer Month* in December, the Miriam College through the Institutional Network for Social Action (INSA) and the College of International, Humanitarian and Development Studies, and the VSO *Bahaginan* will conduct the *National Conference on the Engagement of the Academe in Volunteering (NCEAV)* on December 6-7, 2012 at the Miriam College, Katipunan Avenue, Loyola Heights, Quezon City.

The Conference aims to:

1. make the participants understand the landscape of volunteering in the country and how it relates to the role of the academe (*all about the bigger community*);
