

**PRIVATE BASIC EDUCATION ADMINISTRATORS' SUMMIT ON
K to 12 TRANSITION**
A SEMINAR-WORKSHOP SPONSORED BY CEAP-NBEC AND FAPE
12-13 July 2012

Background and Rationale

The implementation of the K to 12 Education Reform program of the P-Noy government, primarily the Department of Education, shall start this school year with the new curriculum in grades 1 and 7 plus the addition of universal kindergarten before six (6) years of elementary, four (4) years of junior high school and two (2) years of senior high school. The program not only extends the present basic education cycle but enhances the present curriculum as well so that students graduate in basic education ready for employment and/or higher education.

Leading and managing curriculum change is primarily the responsibility of school heads/administrators. CEAP and FAPE would like to assist private school administrators in basic education through this seminar-workshop.

Design of the Seminar-Workshop

The seminar-workshop shall have four (4) parts. Part I shall allow the participants to gain understanding of the K to 12 program and its implementing guidelines as it applies to private institutions.

Part II shall focus on effective change management and people management strategies that schools should employ in light of the transition to the K to 12 enhanced basic education program.

Part III shall focus on two important concerns of private schools: the labor implications and other legal issues relative to the transition and the senior high school curriculum.

Part IV shall be a presentation and discussion of a general strategic planning framework and a planning tool that shall ensure school-specific responses.

Target Participants

Administrators of private basic education schools. Ideal participants for this seminar are school officials who have decision-making authority over the entire school, are expected to take the long-term view and plan the school's direction.
